

Comorbidities often associated with Food Allergies

A multitude of disorders and illnesses have been shown to coexist with food allergies:

Incidence of comorbidities in food allergy¹



Asthma

32% of patients with a single food allergy

49% of patients with multiple food allergies



Atopic dermatitis (Eczema)

33% of patients with a single food allergy

52% of patients with multiple food allergies



Allergic rhinitis

28% of patients with a single food allergy

42% of patients with multiple food allergies

These findings highlight that multiple food allergies likely represent a distinct clinical phenotype from single food allergy
